

2025 CO DANCE RECITAL MAKEUP



Brands listed are studio preference, not required.

- chocolate brown eyeshadow (similar to Covergirl 740 or Annabelle Matte Cocoa)
- Black mascara
- Blush: reddy-burgundy toned such as Covergirl cheekers 154 deep plum, Revlon marvelous 003. Blend along cheekbone to temple. No circles on cheeks.
- Lipstick: reddish-burgundy matte similar to Revlon 740 Certainly Red, Revlon 745 Love In On. No gloss.

ALL DANCERS:

Please no personal jewelry. Remove earrings, rings, etc. If earrings cannot be removed, please ensure they are studs only (NOT dangling ones) and covered with liquid foundation to not catch the lights and sparkle). NO FINGERNAIL OR TOE NAIL POLISH. Remove temporary tattoos. Older dancers should have clear or skin-toned bra straps only. No coloured undergarments. False eyelashes can be worn instead of mascara.

“FOOTSTEPS” dancers should wear stage makeup to help define their features under the bright stage lights, but it is not mandatory. It does not need to be heavy, a light application will still add to their presentation on stage.

Makeup is not needed for boys. Competitive dancers will wear their regular stage makeup, including eyelashes.

“LITTLE STEPS” dancers are not required to wear makeup, however it does help to define their features under the bright stage lights. If they want to wear even just some light blush and lipstick it does add to their overall presentation on stage, and makes recital day an even more extra special event.
